### The Five Workshop Tracks

Each track is a focused, practical workshop. Start at the foundational level, or — if you already work in the trade — go straight into the automotive, ECU or advanced specialisations. Income figures are target operating bands across MyLock's active technician network, *not guaranteed earnings* (full disclosure on page 3).

#### Entry-Level Locksmith

Lock mechanisms, key cutting and basic troubleshooting. The starting point for newcomers to the trade. **2 days.**

RM 4,000–7,000 / mo

#### Smart Lock Installation

Installation, drilling, wiring, configuration and troubleshooting across Yale, Igloohome, Samsung, Kaadas and Philips smart locks. **1 day.**

RM 4,000–12,000 / mo

#### Automotive Locksmith

All-Keys-Lost (AKL), key cloning, transponder/chip handling, EEPROM read/write, OBD programming and safe unlocking. Tooling: Xhorse VVDI, Autel, Lonsdor. **4–10 days.**

RM 6,000–9,000 / mo

#### ECU Specialist

Immobiliser syncing, ECU bench work, MCU/chip desoldering, EEPROM read, data recovery, BDM/JTAG, coding and calibration. Needs foundational automotive experience — not a beginner track. **8–9 days.**

RM 6,000–12,000 / mo

#### Advanced Locksmith

Anti-pick systems, restricted keyways, safebox mechanics, drilling methodology and high-security bypass for established locksmiths moving into commercial and industrial work. **4 days.**

Upper bound (RM 12,000–15,000/mo) reflects a high-end specialist — typically an ECU Specialist or Advanced Locksmith with extended-hours availability. These are target operating bands, not guaranteed earnings. Workshop fees, intake schedule and tool requirements are shared on WhatsApp before you commit — every track has different tool needs.

# How the MyLock Training Pathway Works

Workshops build the skill; the MyLock dispatch pathway is how graduates earn the chance to receive paid jobs through the platform.

Practical, tools-in-hand sessions in the Klang Valley with real locks, keys and vehicles.

We walk through the starter kit and tooling each specialisation needs before you invest.

### Dispatch-Pathway Prep

Onboarding into MyLock's documented dispatch pathway, including a supervised first-10-jobs assessment. Entry is subject to your trainer's approval, ensuring platform service quality.

# Frequently Asked Questions

### Do I need experience to start?

No. The Entry-Level Locksmith track is built for newcomers. The ECU Specialist track does require foundational automotive experience, so it isn't a beginner course.

### How much do the workshops cost?

Fees vary by track and tool requirements, so we share the full outline, intake schedule and costs on WhatsApp before you commit.

### Will I be guaranteed jobs or income after the workshop?

No. The figures here are target operating bands observed across MyLock's technician network, not guaranteed earnings. Graduates earn dispatch eligibility through the documented pathway, including a supervised first-10-jobs assessment.

### Is MyLock an accredited college or academy?

MyLock provides trade-skill workshops and dispatch-pathway preparation. It is not a registered Private Educational Institution and the workshops are not MOE-, SKM/JPK-accredited, or HRD Corp claimable unless a specific intake notice states otherwise.

### Where are the workshops held?

In the Klang Valley (Selangor / Kuala Lumpur). Exact venue and intake dates are confirmed with your advisor when you register.
